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Bog asphodel

A few still occur on the raised bog.





Common cottongrass

A common species on the raised bog.



Common spotted orchid

One of two orchid species that occur in the fen habitat.





Hare's tail cottongrass

A common plant on the raised bog.





Lady's smock

Common in the fen habitat.



Marsh marigold

Common in the wetter areas of the fen habitat.



Meadow sweet

The dominant vegetation through much of the fen habitat.





Northern marsh orchid

A few occur in the fen habitat.





Ragged robin

A common species in the fen habitat.





Round-leaved sundew

Many grow in parts of the raised bog.





Water avens

A common species in the fen habitat.
