Bank vole

Common at Morton Lochs, where it comes to food put out for red squirrels.





Common seal

The common seal used to breed at Tentsmuir Point, and can occasionally be seen there still.





Common shrew

Fairly common. This one was at Morton Lochs.





Field vole

Like the bank vole, the field vole is common at Morton Lochs, where it comes to food put out for red squirrels.





Grey seal

Many haul out at Tentsmuir Point.





Otter

The otter has spread back through Fife, and is now often seen at Morton Lochs and Tentsmuir Point.





Rabbit

Common on the sand dunes and around the Eden Estuary.





Red fox

These were at Morton Lochs.





Red squirrel

Common at Tentsmuir and Morton Lochs. Food is put out for them at Morton Lochs, making them easy to photograph.





Roe deer

Common. They sometimes come out of the forest onto the dunes at Tentsmuir Point, which is where these shots were taken.
